Neighbor-to-Neighbor trainings are open to the general public and are also an avenue for training potential Neighbor-to-Neighbor volunteer mediators who wish to assist Neighbor-to-Neighbor in fulfilling the mission of providing dispute resolution services to residents of Marion County and West Salem.

To register, please submit an application with your registration fee. Since the training is limited to 24 participants, we recommend that you submit your application as early as possible. You must attend and participate in all sessions of the training in order to receive a Certificate of Completion for the training.

Training Costs...

- Individual rate: **\$495**
- Volunteer rates: **\$295** when you agree to volunteer for Neighbor-to-Neighbor for 40 hours within one year.
- **\$95** if you become a volunteer mediator for 80 hours within one year.

Additional partial scholarships are available for new volunteers with special skills, especially bilingual mediators. Bilingual includes ASL, Spanish and Russian. Other languages will be considered.
